

Japan's Response to the Syrian Crisis

as of October 2015



Assistance to the Syrian Crisis reached **approx. USD 1.147 billion**

Additional Support in 2015 (approx. **USD 509 million+200 million+12 million**)

- USD 509 million** announced in Kuwait 3 Conference on 31st March ※Italic is additional support decided by September.
 - Providing humanitarian assistance to IDPs in Syria and Syrian refugees in its neighboring countries (Lebanon, Jordan, Turkey and Iraq) as well as host communities in those countries, in areas such as health and sanitation, education and food: **approx. USD 116 million**
 - Providing emergency aid such as winterization non-food items and additional foods for IDPs in Syria and Syrian refugees in its neighboring countries (Lebanon, Jordan and Turkey) : **USD 6 million**
 - Providing grant aid such as medical equipment etc. to Jordan: **approx. USD 16.7 million**
 - Yen loans to improve infrastructure in local communities in Turkey affected by Syrians: **approx. USD 370 million**
- Yen loans to stabilize economy and finances in Jordan affected by Syrians (May 2015) : approx. **USD 200 million**
- Providing humanitarian assistance to IDPs in Syria and Syrian refugees in its neighboring countries, including USD 2 million emergency aid such as Syrian refugees and host communities in Lebanon: approx. **USD 12 million**※*

Support by the end of 2014 (approx. **USD 426 million**)

- Humanitarian and Other Assistance (approx. USD 406 million)
 - Japan's humanitarian assistance for the Syrian crisis: **approx. USD 286 million**, examples are as follows;
 - Providing assistance through international organizations and Japanese NGOs in areas such as health and sanitation, education and food
 - "Cross border" assistance such as providing commodities through Japanese NGOs, providing medical equipment and conducting training for Syrians in third country
 - Contribution in kind to International Organization for Migration(IOM) in accordance with the International Peacekeeping Cooperation Law (Providing goods, such as tents and blankets, for Syrian refugees in Turkey and Iraq)
 - Yen loans to contribute to the stabilization of Jordan that is facing a sharp increase in burden due to the high influx of Syrian refugees: **approx. USD 120 million.**
- Financial contribution to the process of the destruction of chemical weapons: approx. USD 20 million
